Dear Parent/Guardian,

Re: Year 11 Study Leave

All Year 11 students will be expected to attend school full time until 27th May. Compulsory scheduled revision sessions will take place throughout the examination period until the start of study leave. Students must be in school during this period and will follow the normal timetable when they are not required for revision sessions.

On Thursday 27th May students will follow the normal timetable until 11.30 a.m., followed by a celebration assembly from 11.30 a.m. – 12.30 p.m. Study Leave will commence from 12.30 p.m.

During the period of Study Leave, students will be required to attend school only for examinations and further revision sessions, should they wish to take advantage of these. At all other times, with your agreement, they may study at home. We can provide study facilities for students who prefer to remain in school and we ask you to indicate your wishes on the reply slip below. **Please note that if the slip is not returned, students will not be able to take advantage of study leave at home.**

Students have already been provided with an examination timetable. It is essential that students arrive at the exam room at least 10 minutes before the start time shown on the timetable. Students must also wear full school uniform at all times when they are in school.

On the reverse of this letter there is a timetable indicating subject specific revision sessions that are taking place during Study Leave. Whilst attendance is not compulsory, all research shows that attendance at these sessions helps to improve examination performance.
