Denbigh School students are celebrating winning the Milton Keynes Family Court Mock Trial Competition. The Competition challenged Sixth Form students from across Milton Keynes to take on the roles associated with cases that are dealt with in Family Court.

Denbigh students excelled in taking on the roles of advocates, legal advisers and magistrates in two mock cases relating to care arrangements for children. As part of their preparation, the students had to prepare an urgent non-molestation order, which was then presented to a serving judge. During the day, the students had the opportunity to speak to magistrates, judges and the High Sherriff of Buckingham, who helped them gain a real understanding of the work of the family courts.
