



Denbigh is top in MK at GCSE & A Level

Denbigh is celebrating being recognised as the top school in Milton Keynes for the progress its students make at GCSE and A Level, following the publication of key Government Performance tables. The GCSE Performance tables, published in February, have been revised since they were last made available in October to include re-marks. The School was delighted to see its 'Progress 8' Score, a key Government benchmark which measures the progress students make from the time they join the School until they take their GCSE exams, increase from 0.26 to 0.29, making it the top school in MK. This also puts the School into the top 22% of schools nationally. The A Level Performance tables which were published in January showed that Denbigh was the top school in MK for the progress its students make between GCSE and A Level – also known as 'A Level Value Added'.
