# Welcome from the Headteacher



Welcome to our Sports Awards Ceremony, our annual celebration of the culture of sporting success and participation we have here at Denbigh. Encouraging and supporting our students in their sporting endeavours, whether that be participating in an after-school sports club right up to being selected for an England Development Squad, is central to who we are as a school community.

Participation in sport brings with it benefits for our students in terms of their health and fitness and develops self-confidence, perseverance and team working skills.

Tonight, we are celebrating those students who have shown the highest levels of talent and commitment when representing our school by awarding them their Half or Full Colours. We will also award PE Curriculum Awards, which recognise those students who have excelled academically and those who have made an outstanding contribution to the subject. Our 'Players Player of the Year' awards, as voted by teammates, will also be presented along with awards from our successful Football Academy. All the students recognised today are listed in this Brochure along with the names of those who have regularly been members of our sports teams. The Brochure also records the 31 students who have achieved regional or national recognition this year in their sporting fields.

This year's sporting highlights have included our Year 10 and Under 18 Boys Football teams reaching county cup finals and our Year 7 Boys Football Team reaching the semi-finals of the county cup. The Under 18 Boys Team draws from students in our popular Football Academy which, from September, will work in partnership with the MK Dons Sport & Education Trust. This partnership will give our Academy students the opportunity to train and compete in a high-performance environment at the MK

Dons and allow boys from the MK Dons Talent Pathway the opportunity to progress academically within our Academy. This close working relationship is recognition of our Academy's excellent local reputation. Established in 1999, it is the most established post-16 provider of football education within Milton Keynes.

Last summer, we won the MK Schools Athletics Federation Cup, beating 14 MK secondary schools to bring home the cup for the first time in seven years – a fantastic team effort. We are currently MK schools champions in Badminton, Basketball and Football.

We have also seen some remarkable individual success stories from our students in terms of their sporting activities out of school, including representing GB at the Wakeboarding World Championships, winning European gold medals in Judo and being named Buckinghamshire's Archer of the Year.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the staff in our PE Faculty, listed below, who match the commitment of our students and always go the extra mile when encouraging, coaching and motivating them. Without them none of this success would have been possible. One example of this is that every year our PE staff, assisted by our Football Academy students, organise the MK Secondary Schools Cross Country Championships at Campbell Park, which this year involved 367 runners from 14 MK schools and was a fantastic event.

Thank you for joining us today and helping to make this celebration truly special for all the students and staff.
