- Provide a balanced curriculum and consider the individual needs of your child.
- Achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and promoting our school values 'be engaged, be kind and respectful, do no harm'.
- Promote zero tolerance to bullying, discrimination, and misogyny by following the School's 'Call It In' Programme.
- Support your child so that they achieve their best as a valued member of the school community.
- Keep you informed about general school matters and about your child's progress and wellbeing.

- Demonstrate the school values of 'be engaged, be kind and respectful, do no harm' at all times, co-operating fully with members of staff and other students.
- Demonstrate positive behaviour at all times including on the way to and from school.
- Be polite and helpful to others.
- Follow the School's 'Call It In' Programme by not bullying, discriminating, or being misogynistic toward any of my peers or members of staff.
- Wear the correct school uniform correctly and be tidy in appearance.
- Do all my classwork and homework as well as I can, ensuring I bring all the equipment I need every day.
- Use the school resources, including all ICT facilities, correctly and appropriately.
